The Priest River Wrestling Club provides the Singlets free of charge. However, the singlets are only on loan for the season and must be returned to the Club no later than the end of season party. Please take care of your wrestler's singlet by washing and gently drying after each tournament. Singlets only need to be worn for photo night and each tournament. If you do not return the singlet or it becomes damaged beyond repair, the replacement cost is \$50. The team singlet provides the wrestlers with a sense of membership and club unity. It also gives the coaches and membership the ability to locate our Club Wrestlers to coach and encourage them during their matches. ALL WRESTLERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR CLUB SINGLET AT ALL TOURNAMENTS DURING THE SEASON.
